A man using a workbench looks through the car hood of his vehicle at his workbench...Use of adjuvants such as solvent or hydrophilic detergents may facilitate dissolution of an active ingredient by the stratum corneum. Even if a solubilising adjuvant can be physically absorbed in the skin, hydrophobic adjuvants may only partially extract the solubilised active ingredient into the skin. This may lead to less than optimum active ingredient delivery. Previously EP 0 928 318 suggested a method for the preparation of preferably clear gels by dispersing waxes in alcohols or water and adding the active ingredient to the dispersion. The '318 patent does not describe the preparation of gels that are effective as active ingredient delivery enhancers. Furthermore, the low solubility of waxes (est. 10-20° C.) in alcohol makes it difficult to manufacture a homogeneous dispersion. Moreover, the comparatively high boiling point of alcohol may not be convenient for sterilisation, especially at elevated temperatures, as in the manufacturing of gels.
