This book is not the only book that teaches you how to use Photoshop, but it is the best, especially for beginners. The first chapters introduce you to the basic concepts, principles, and terminology that every new user needs to know to get started. Most of the other books that cover Photoshop's basic functions and features focus more on advanced techniques, skills, and features that are really

outside the scope of this book. Even for advanced users who are reading this book right now, however, you'll find that you can easily adapt the projects in this book into other software tools, too. For example, some of the images in this book can be easily made in other programs such as GIMP (see Chapter 14) and Picasa (see Chapter 11) as well. The book covers all the major Photoshop functions, including the basics, the essentials, and all of the

advanced topics, such as retouching, cloning, and composite shots. You'll work with the Creative Suite programs, including Photoshop Elements. This book goes beyond merely providing you with an introduction to Photoshop, and in fact, goes so far as to show you how to create step-by-step projects that you can actually use, solve problems, and add features to your photos. ## Considering the Hardware Needed to Use

Photoshop Photoshop is available for PCs running the following Operating Systems:

- Microsoft Windows 8 • Microsoft Windows 7 • Mac OS X 10.5 Leopard or later • Mac OS X 10.4 Tiger

Photoshop is available for Windows XP and Vista from Adobe. You can also use Photoshop on a Mac with Mac OS X 10.4 Tiger or later. However, on a Mac, it's recommended that you use Adobe Photoshop CS6 or Photoshop Elements 8 or later. The most recent software from

each series is always the best choice because the features in each newer version are built on top of the features in the older version. Always make sure that your computer is running the best operating system possible. For maximum compatibility and performance, I recommend the following:

- A Windows system running Windows 7
- A MacBook running OS X 10.6 Snow Leopard
- An older-model laptop running Windows XP or Vista.

Photoshop CS6 is the latest version of Photoshop, the CS6 version is not compatible with all older Windows systems, and may not work on some models of Intel Macs. Therefore, if you have a
